Registration:

- Students must be affiliated (entered into the affiliation system by November 1 and an invoice created) by **November 1st**. Your affiliation payment must be paid to nationals by **December 1** (nationals must receive and credit your account). **There is absolutely no exception to this rule.**

Evaluators:

- Each school is required to bring 2 adults to serve as evaluators and 1 student to serve as a room consultant. The adviser can count as 1 adult evaluator.
 - Student volunteers should be reliable and understand the responsibilities of being a room consultant. They will need to bring a device in order to fill in the room consultant part of the rubrics.
- Each chapter with STAR Event participants must fill out the Region 2 STAR Event volunteer [Google Form](#). The volunteer form must be filled out before the participants from a chapter will be put into the competition schedule.
- Each evaluator must bring their own device for scoring.

Competition Schedule

- The competition schedule will be posted online, no later than December 29, 2025. Lead consultants, evaluators and room consultants will also be notified of their assignments at this time.

Participant Orientation

- An online STAR Event participant orientation will be posted on the Region 2 website by January 1, 2026. Participants must watch the presentation and fill out the orientation document. The orientation document must be submitted to the room consultant at the time the participant(s) competes.

Dress:

- All STAR Events competitors must follow the Missouri FCCLA Official Dress code when presenting or will lose points for not following the event dress code. <https://missourifccla.org/attend/dress-code/>
 - FCCLA red blazer (must have the FCCLA emblem on the pocket or FCCLA embroidered on the chest of the jacket)
 - Red, Black or white polo or professional white shirt (long or short sleeves)
 - Black or khaki bottoms (slacks, skirt or sheath dress)
 - Shoes (black preferred)
- Adult evaluators & room consultants should wear business professional attire.

Postponement

- Region 2 STAR Events will be postponed if any chapter that is competing cancels school the day of STAR Events. Advisers must notify Kristi Christy by 5:00 am on the day of competition if their school is closed for the day. The postponed snow date will be January 29th, 2026.

Results & Medals

- The top 2 Gold in each event category will advance to state competition.
- Results will be posted to the Region 2 Website by 10:00 p.m. on the day of STAR Events.
- Rubrics will be released within 1 week of the event through DLG.

- **Medals will be handed out at the Region 2 Meeting during the 2026 State Leadership Conference. Chapters not in attendance can pay to have medals shipped to their school.**
